

# THE GOLDEN GATE

by Amy Chua

Did one of them have a reason to kill Wilkinson? Did Madame Chiang Kai-Shek, in residence in Berkeley under opaque circumstances, have something to do with his presence at the Claremont? What about the Communist labor radicals, whose hatred of Wilkinson's establishment ties were matched only by the brutality of police repression? Caught between an ambitious D.A., the heiresses' iron-willed grandmother, the geopolitical forces of the war, and his conflicted attraction to the fascinating Isabella, Sullivan must navigate a landscape in which his own history is a double-edged sword.

It is about the possibility of living between multiple worlds and not choosing—but instead charting a new path entirely.

But the stars called her back and she returned to her first love—astronomy—and resumed her acclaimed research on exoplanetary ice and weather. Now, Dr Shields is a Clare Boothe Luce Associate Professor at the University of California, Irvine where she focuses on exploring the possible climates and potential habitability of extrasolar planets, particularly those orbiting low-mass stars. Dr Shields uses her theater and writing background to communicate science to the public in engaging, innovative ways. A mother of a young daughter, Aomawa is writing this book to share her knowledge of what life on other planets can teach us about our own home.

### The Tiny Steps That Lead to The Biggest Accomplishments

The promise of MICROSKILLS is simple: every big goal, complicated task, healthy habit, and even what we think of as innate character traits, can be broken down into simple, measurable, and *tiny* skills that can be easily practiced and mastered.

In the tradition of ATOMIC HABITS and THE CHECKLIST MANIFESTO, Dr. Landry and Dr. Lewis have identified the major issues with the ways we learn, work, and measure success—and almost all those issues can be solved with a set of small actions:

Microskills turn lofty goals like “increasing productivity” into little, concrete actions you can practice daily, like keeping count of your available hours each day to prevent over-committing and highlights how what we consider as innate character traits that you either “have it, or you don’t” are skills that can be practiced and mastered. Microskills help us identify knowledge gaps early by breaking down assignments into their smallest component steps and outlines the problems that can be avoided by making assumptions, or not asking for help. Without reinventing the wheel, Microskills is a way to re-work what you are already doing, but to make it better.

As women in medicine, Dr. Landry and Dr. Lewiss knew from the beginning that they would have to work twice as hard to get just as far as their white male colleagues. Dr. Lewiss was the first female professor of emergency medicine in her department. Dr. Landry was the sole Black woman faculty member in her department for 6 years.

Survival in that environment goes beyond grit and passion, it requires strategic navigation and understanding—which is how the authors began developing their Microskills.

Dr. Lewiss and Dr. Landry have spoken on stages like TEDmed, appeared as guests on popular business and education podcasts, and written for *Forbes*, *Fast Company*, *Nature*, *Science*, and *The Harvard Business Review*. Their work has also been featured in *The New York Times*, *Slate*, *USA Today*, and more. Dr. Lewiss is a Harvard, UPenn, and Brown University trained ER Physician and Professor at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, and Dr. Landry is an ER Physician and Assistant Professor at Harvard Medical School. Both award-winning mentors who have taught hundreds of students and physicians how to work effectively and efficiently when the stakes are high and the odds are unfavorable.




